The protection of your personal data is important to us.

With this information, we the members of the TEF-Health Consortium would like to inform you about the processing of your personal data and your rights. For data protection reasons, your data can only be processed if this is permitted by law or if you have given your consent.

(3) Purposes and legal bases of processing

Your data will be processed to fulfil the purposes listed below on the basis of the legal basis specified there:

(4) Data categories

We process the following categories of data to fulfil the above-mentioned purposes:

(5) Source of the data [only required for indirect data collection (Art. 14 GDPR)]

(6) Recipients or categories of recipients of the personal data

Your personal data will be passed on to the recipients or groups of recipients:

(7) Transfer of personal data to a third country

It is not planned to transfer your personal data to third countries/an international organisation outside the European Union and the European Economic Area for the purpose of informing the public, for which the European Commission has not determined an adequate level of data protection.

(8) Duration of storage of personal data or criteria for determining this duration

Your data will be stored by us until the purpose of the processing (see 3) is no longer applicable, you revoke your consent *or* you object to the data processing for reasons arising from your particular situation.

(9) Data processing risks and security measures

With every collection, storage and transmission of data, *there is* a residual risk of traceability to your person due to the inclusion of further information, e.g. from the Internet or social networks.

We assure you that we will do everything possible in accordance with the state of the art to protect your privacy. This includes a corresponding contractual assurance of the protection of the intended purpose and confidentiality by the data recipients.

(10) Rights of data subjects and making contact

You have the following rights in connection with the processing of your data:

Right to withdraw your consent, Art. 7 GDPR

If you have consented to the processing via a corresponding declaration, you can revoke your consent at any time for the future without any disadvantages. The legality of the processing carried out up to that point remains unaffected.

Right to object to data processing, Art. 21 GDPR

If we process your data on the legal basis of Art. 6 para. 1 lit. e or legitimate interest Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f GDPR, you have the right to object.

Right to information, Art. 15 GDPR

You have the right to information about the personal data stored about you.

Right to rectification, Art. 16 GDPR

If you discover that incorrect personal data relating to you is being processed, you can request rectification. Incomplete data must be completed, taking into account the purpose of the processing.

Right to erasure, Art. 17 GDPR

You have the right to request the erasure of your data if certain grounds for erasure apply. This is particularly the case if it is no longer required for the purpose for which it was originally collected or processed.

Right to restriction of processing, Art. 18 GDPR

You have the right to restrict the processing of your data. This means that although your data will not be deleted, it will be labelled in order to restrict its further processing or use.

Data portability, Art. 20 GDPR

Personal data provided by you may be made available to you in a commonly used structured format, where technically feasible.

Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority:
